Gospel Baptist Church exists to make and mature disciples in our neighborhood and the nations. Because of that, we are seeking a full-time Next-Generation Pastor to serve in our children's through college ministries.

Over the past two years, Gospel has seen tremendous growth, averaging 460 on a Sunday morning with a multi-generational congregation.

Our church campus has a demographic of 85,000 people, 45,000 of whom are unchurched. We pray that God leads the right candidate to fill this position as we strive to make mature disciples in northern Greensboro and across the nations.
